


Keeping Slides Clear

IMAGES

- 1500 pixels on the long edge
- Use conservatively
- Break up text, add variety

TEXT

- > 16 point font size
- Sans serif font
- Contrasting colors



Highlighting Details in a Slide

Save time through:

- Duplicating slides and images
- Use arrows and boxes







Emphasizing Text

"An example of a sentence where a part of the sentence might be highlighted to emphasize a point. Changing the highlighted text can transition to a new section. New sections can be highlighted from the same passage."

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Presenting Remotely


Zoom

- External monitor for presenter notes
- Use <u>Sidecar</u> to add an iPad as second screen
